Francis inspires confession boom

The number of people asking for the sacrament of reconciliation has jumped since the election of Pope Francis, Italian priests say. (...) "There has been a considerable increase in the number of people who have started asking for confession again," said Fr. Paolo Padrini, parish priest of Stanzanno, a village in the Northern Italian province of Alessandria. He mentioned one elderly catechist in particular, who following his sermon, quoted Bergoglio: "you smell like your flock... My altar boys heard the Pope's sermon at the Casal del Marmo prison for young offenders [Holy Thursday], in video streaming and were struck by his reference to the "caress of God."

"A lot of people I confessed I hadn't seen for a long time – Fr Domenico Sirtori, parish priest of the Church of San Maurizio on Solbiate, a village in the Northern Italian province of Varese. "They told me they came because they felt they could relate to the new Pope. People had felt the Church as something distant from them.
